Undergraduate Business Open House and Kenan-Flagler Club Fair

Do your best to register for 1 and no more than two of the following business prerequisites this fall semester:

- Calculus-based math (MATH 152, MATH 231, or STOR 113) MATH 110 placement required.
- ECON 101
- BUSI 100
- STOR 155

Business prerequisites must be complete with a C (not C-) or better. Avoid taking more than two quantitative/analytical courses (Economics, Math, Sciences, etc.) together in your first semester. It is a marathon and not a sprint, and it is best not to overload your schedule in the first semester so that you have time to engage outside of the classroom as well. AP By Exam (BE) and transfer credit equivalencies for business prerequisites are accepted, and we would not recommend repeating courses for which you already have credit.

Admissions Counseling

All pre-business academic advising questions should be directed to **advisors within the College of Arts & Sciences/UNC Advising**. Members of the UBP Admissions team also offer a limited number of admissions-related counseling appointments during the fall and spring semesters to address specific questions that are not addressed in the large group programming. These appointments will be available within the **UNC Academic Advising Hub Scheduler** starting the second week of classes.

Business Admissions Information

The application to the business school opens for rising sophomores on July 1 with a September 1 deadline. The admissions committee conducts a comprehensive evaluation, considering multiple factors such as academic performance at UNC and progress in business school prerequisites, as well as the applicant's drive for business at Kenan-Flagler. Additionally, we assess campus involvement and the potential for the candidate to make a positive impact on our Undergraduate Business and Kenan-Flagler community. Our evaluation process takes a holistic approach, aiming to understand the applicant's overall potential for success.

All decisions are released mid-October (before spring registration). Admitted students will participate in orientation and begin receiving access to business school resources almost immediately. However, access to business courses is determined by prerequisite standing at time of admission. Admitted students on track to complete their business prerequisites within the fall semester will receive admission to start business classes in the spring. Admitted students with one prerequisite remaining for the spring semester will receive admission, but will not begin their business courses until all prerequisites are complete.

As mentioned during our session, we offer pre-business and application-readiness programming throughout the first year and will communicate these opportunities both on our external website and via the mailing list for which you are subscribed.
