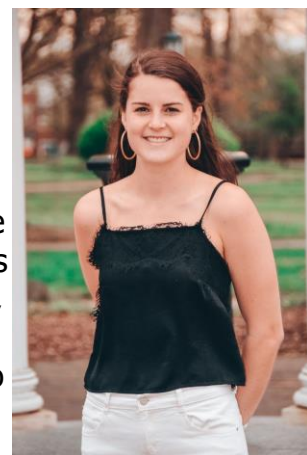

Hear from Avery Harris, Class of 2022, as she shares some words of wisdom fitting for Pre-Business students.

"One of my key takeaways from my experience at Capital One is the importance of authenticity in the workplace. For someone with no coding background, I was overwhelmed at first by the highly technical nature of this internship. With time, I was able to get more comfortable expressing my discomfort to my team members. By being authentic, I was able to feel embraced by my peers but also was given the resources I needed to learn and build my confidence in skills I was originally less familiar with. I learned more than I could've imagined about data, the cloud, and coding but none of that learning would have been possible if I hadn't expressed my discomfort early and been unafraid of asking for support."
