Health and Wellness Resources

Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS)	Brief individual therapy, group therapy, referral support to long-term therapy
Campus Health Services	Immunizations, allergy services, gynecology, nutrition services, pharmacy, primary care, radiology, medical academic interventions, ADHD, gender affirming care
UNC Student Wellness	One-on-one wellness coaching, programming/workshops
Campus Recreation	Group fitness, personal training services (additional fee), outdoor education expeditions, climbing gym
Accessibility Resources and Services	Accessibility accommodations, assistive technology (AT), academic translation and interpretation services
LGBTQ Center	Drop-in spaces, workshops, trainings, LGBTIQ+ speaker series, Trans Talk Tuesday (peer support group)
Veterans Resource Center	Academic and career workshops, front desk peer advising, social and wellness events
Writing & Learning Center	Academic coaching, writing coaching, peer tutoring, ADHD and LD support
