The Undergraduate Business Program (UBP) welcomes you to UNC Kenan-Flagler Business School. For over 100 years, students have come to Carolina to study business. Our mission is to build and inspire leaders who make the world a better place.

The McColl Building is the home of the Undergraduate Business, Master of Accounting, MBA and PhD programs, and the School's faculty and staff. We are located on the edge of the University campus and adjacent to the Dean E. Smith Center, one of the most recognized athletic venues in the U.S.

The flags representing the nationalities of UNC Kenan-Flagler students have greeted everyone entering the McColl Building for many years. Flags that represent the School's diversity – including LGBTQ+ Pride flag, Black Lives Matter, the Pan-African flag and Native American flags – hang in front of Koury Auditorium, a central gathering place for our community.

Our facilities include multimedia classrooms, study and social spaces, small break-out rooms, the Capital Markets Lab and Café McColl.

Our building is named for Hugh L. McColl Jr. (BSBA '57), former chairman and CEO of Bank of America.

## McCOLL LEVEL 1 / GROUND FLOOR

### TECHNOLOGY CENTER *McColl 1st Floor*

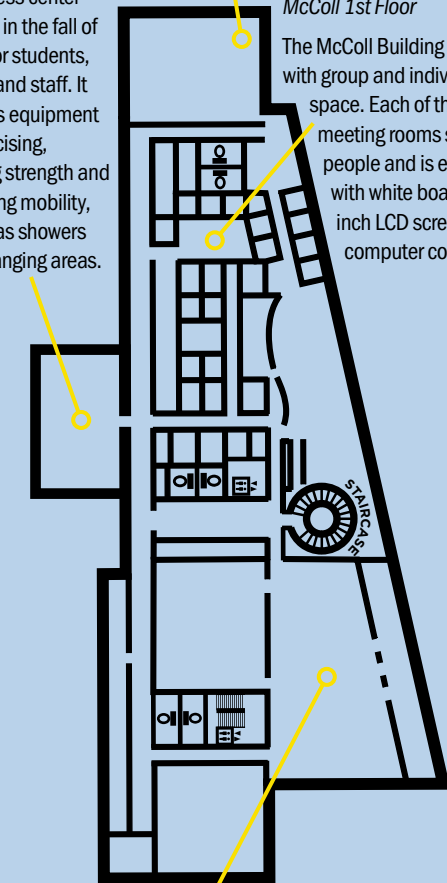
The lab has 32 machines, plus a multimedia room with scanner and resume printer. Students have 24-hour access to the lab with two networked printers.

### FITNESS CENTER *McColl 1st Floor*

The fitness center opened in the fall of 2016 for students, faculty and staff. It includes equipment for exercising, building strength and improving mobility, as well as showers and changing areas.

### STUDENT STUDY SPACES *McColl 1st Floor*

The McColl Building is equipped with group and individual study space. Each of the 24 group meeting rooms seats six people and is equipped with white boards and 32-inch LCD screen TVs with computer connections.



### CAFÉ McCOLL *McColl 1st Floor*

Café McColl has an indoor capacity of 280 seats serving a variety of dining choices. The Café is wireless, as is the rest of the campus and has outlets for all seating areas, a phone charging station and an ATM machine.

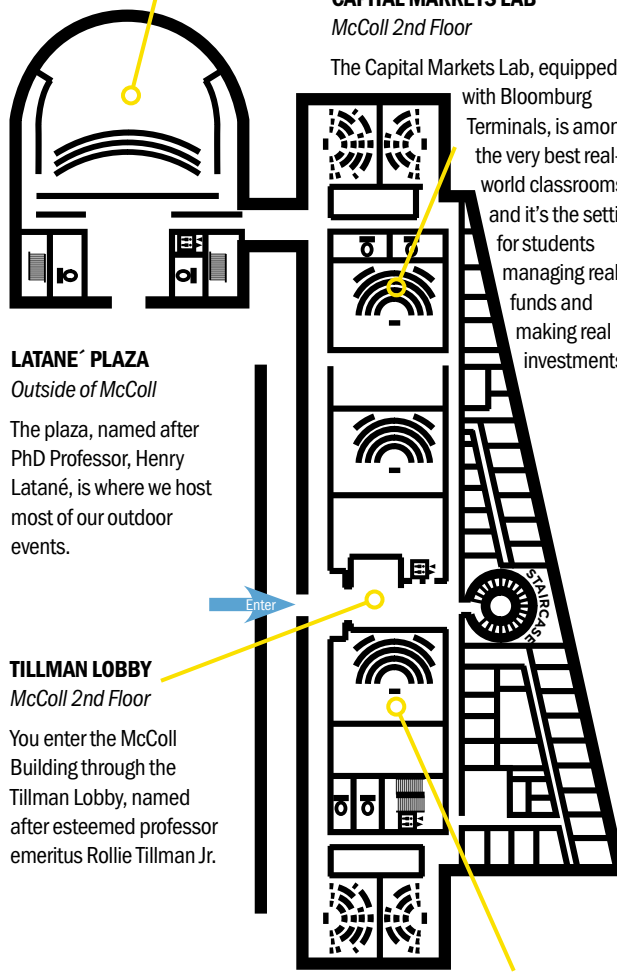
## McCOLL LEVEL 2 / MAIN ENTRANCE

### KOURY AUDITORIUM *McColl 2nd Floor*

Koury Auditorium is the building to your right outside of the McColl Building and connected by an elevated walkway. The 350-seat auditorium is where MBA students have meetings and review sessions, and where community lectures are held. In Loudermilk lobby, flags hang that represent the full diversity of the UNC Kenan-Flagler community.

### CAPITAL MARKETS LAB *McColl 2nd Floor*

The Capital Markets Lab, equipped with Bloomberg Terminals, is among the very best real-world classrooms and it's the setting for students managing real funds and making real investments.



### LATANE' PLAZA *Outside of McColl*

The plaza, named after PhD Professor, Henry Latané, is where we host most of our outdoor events.

### TILLMAN LOBBY *McColl 2nd Floor*

You enter the McColl Building through the Tillman Lobby, named after esteemed professor emeritus Rollie Tillman Jr.

### KENAN CENTER *Building adjacent to the McColl Building*

The Kenan Center houses the Frank Hawkins Kenan Institute of Private Enterprise and other centers, programs and departments of the business school.

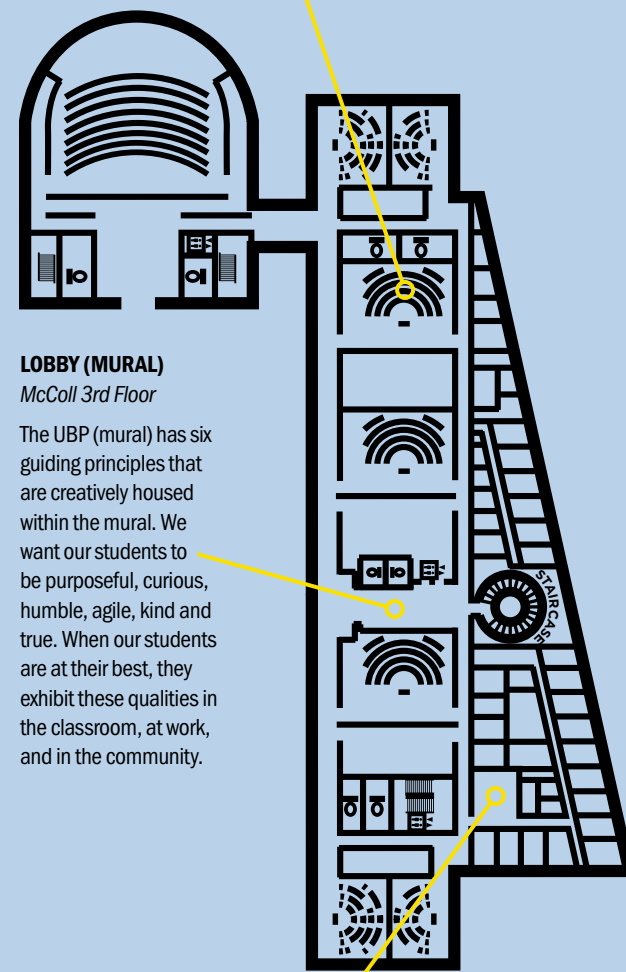
### MBA CLASSROOMS *McColl 2nd Floor*

The second floor houses MBA classrooms.

## McCOLL LEVEL 3 / UBP FLOOR

### UBP CLASSROOMS *McColl 3rd Floor*

Class sizes range from 20-45 students with most rooms that accommodate 50. The classrooms are designed so every student has a good seat, with nametag holders, power outlets and a good view of the professor. Each room can teleconference and video record (if a student has to miss class) and has a host of other presentation capabilities.



### LOBBY (MURAL) *McColl 3rd Floor*

The UBP (mural) has six guiding principles that are creatively housed within the mural. We want our students to be purposeful, curious, humble, agile, kind and true. When our students are at their best, they exhibit these qualities in the classroom, at work, and in the community.

### UBP OFFICE *McColl 3rd Floor*

Business majors and minors have exclusive access to a dedicated team of staff advising and coaching resources to meet their academic, extra-curricular, career and wellness needs. Students also benefit from a specialized study abroad office with a unique portfolio of over 40 programs in over 20 countries.
